## The Law

<u>The Rehabilitation Act of 1973</u>: bans discrimination based on disability in federal programs and federal funding institutions.

<u>Section 508</u>: is a part of The Rehabilitation Act of 1973. It is a law that requires all federal agencies to provide people with disabilities equal access to electronic and information technologies.

<u>The Americans with Disabilities Act</u>: prohibits discrimination against people with disabilities. People with disabilities are entitled to the same rights and opportunities as able-bodied people.

## ADA Library Examples:

- 1. Tables at the library should have 27-inch high clearance and 19 inches of depth.
- 2. The space between furniture should be 40 inches.
- 3. The top row at the stacks shouldn't be higher than 48 inches.
- 4. Aisles should have at least 36 inches of clearance, but 42 inches is preferred.
- 5. Service desks (reference, check out, etc.) shouldn't be higher than 36 inches.
- 6. The floor should be smooth and bump-free.
